2010 Miss Trumbull County Fair Pageant

1. Must be a resident of Trumbull County.
2. Must be 16 through 19 years of age before June 27, 2010.
3. Must be single, never married, no children and not pregnant on June 27, 2010.
4. Must submit an application to the Trumbull County Agricultural Society Office or postmarked on or before Friday, June 11, 2010. First 15 applications will be accepted. Applications received after this date will be considered ineligible. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.**
5. The pageant and judging will be held on the Historical Stage at the Trumbull County Fairground at 7:00 pm on June 28, 2010. The judges' decision will be final.
6. Contestants will appear on stage in an evening or formal wear. Wear shoes that are comfortable. Please do not show too much skin. Improper evening and formal wear will **NOT** be accepted.
7. Contestants are required to submit two questions for use during the contest. The contents of each question should deal with current events and issues concerning teenagers today. Any question that we feel is inappropriate will not be used.
8. Contestant's Pageant Application will be reviewed by the panel of judges prior to the contestants appearing on stage. Once on stage, candidates will present a short speech on themselves. After all the introductions are finished, each candidate will answer a question, chosen at random, from those submitted by the candidates.
9. A meeting for the contestants will be held at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 at the Fairgrounds Office Building on Everett Hull Rd., Gate C. Please have your two questions ready to be turned in at this meeting. If you are unable to attend this meeting, please contact the Pageant Coordinator.
10. A rehearsal will be held on the Historical Stage at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, June 22, 2010. Please bring the shoes that you will be wearing to practice walking on the stage.
11. Contestants will be permitted **ONLY FEMALE** attendants in the dressing room on the night of the contest.

12. The individual contestant(s) will be responsible for any damage done to the dressing rooms by themselves or their attendant. The Trumbull County Agricultural Society will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
